




1. Tullamore Depot

- Expected completion in Q2 of 2026
- Waterways Ireland will then vacate Tullamore Harbour site.

Draft Masterplan Agreed March 2024


6 Week Public Consultation closed 26 July 2024

10 Oct 2024 — WI and OCC meet Tullamore MD. Masterplan accepted.


2026 – Waterways Ireland will vacate the site. Development commences.



3. Shannon Harbour

Shannon Harbour Visitor Berths


- Detailed design largely complete
- 300 metres of serviced jetty
- Estimated Value €650k
- JTF application submitted Oct 2024
- If approved should cover 80% cost
- Possible programme for delivery:
 - Jan 2025 Anticipated JTF decision
 - Feb 2025 Tender
 - Mar 2025 Evaluate
 - Apr 2025 Award
 - Aug 2025 Mobilisation
 - Sep 2025 Commence works
 - On water commences after bird nesting season
 - Dec 2025 Anticipated completion

- Proposed development of spur line aim for Just Transition. FI Partnership application. At tender stage for consultancy to prepare submission including planning permission

- VEDP costings & other info being developed

Grand Canal Animation

- VEDP being drawn up
- Scope to be defined for JTF application to mirror Royal Canal application
- BnM Trail interactions in Offaly and elsewhere awaiting consultation

- Possible delivery in 2026




10. Barrow Blueway

- Landscaping upgrades






















